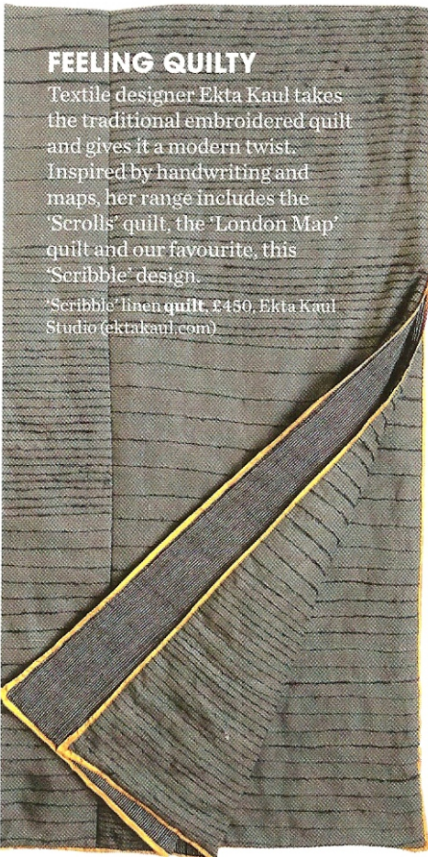
## COOL CONCRETE
